

Below are the four major findings from the report.




62% of organizations **don't have a team** to address cyber attacks on executives' personal devices.

Only 26% of those surveyed are highly confident that their executives would know how to protect their personal computer from viruses.



Less than half are highly confident that executives would know how to **secure**their personal email.
